# MILLIONAIRE SHORTBREAD

2 cups flour
1-1/2 cup brown sugar
1 tsp. salt
2 cups cold butter divided
1-1/2 tsp vanilla, divided
1/4 cup light corn syrup
1-14 oz. can sweetened condensed milk
3/4 lb. milk or dark chocolate (I used bag of morsels)

Oven: 325 degrees

line 9 x 13 in. pan with parchment paper and butter the paper.

Shortbread: Measure the flour, 1/2 cup brown sugar, and 1/2 tsp. salt into food processor and pulse til mixed. Add 1 cup of butter in chunks and pulse til roughly mixed. Add 1/2 tsp. vanilla. Continue to process till dough begins to form a ball. Remove from processor and press evenly over the bottom of pan. Bake for 35-40 min. or till golden brown throughout.

Caramel: Melt the remaining 1 cup butter over low head. Stir in the remaining 1 cup brown sugar, corn syrup, and condensed milk. Raise heat to medium low; bring to a boil, stirring constantly for 4 min. Stir in the vanilla and remaining 1/2 tsp. salt. Pour over the baked crust evenly and let cool.

Melt the chocolate and pour it evenly over the caramel layer. Cool completely in the pan. Lift out using the parchment paper. Cut into squares and enjoy.

Yield: 36-40 cookies depending on how big/small you cut them.

Once or twice a year the Club has work days where members may paint, do repairs or chop wood for the woodstove in winter. They also have a meeting in Dec., where each club picks dates for its events. If you have never been do plan on coming this year and run your dog in an event. Pointers love the open fields and the woods that are full of game birds and wildlife. When it is not hunting season you can come and run your dog it is great excise for two or four footed companions.

Dear Rich,

This letter will serve as DEEP's report for the 2011 FFTA annual meeting. The past year continued to be a productive field season at the Flaherty Field Trial Area. Several projects were accomplished to improve both the habitat and operational facilities on the property. Project activities included:

- DEEP staff mowed approximately 150 acres during the month of August. This acreage included 70 acres enrolled with the US Dept of Agriculture under an existing Wildlife Habitat Incentives Program (WHIP) contract.
- As a follow-up treatment under this same WHIP grant 10 acres were herbicided with the general
  use selective herbicide (Garlon 3a) targeting non-native invasive plants (i.e. autumn olive,
  barberry, bittersweet and multi-flora rose) in an attempt to reduce mowing requirements over the
  long-term.
- Three agricultural agreements were administered. These agreements provided services including the establishment of 10 food plots and the delivery of screened topsoil.
- DEEP purchased \$20,000 of processed gravel, rented equipment and utilized agency staff to develop a new parking site located at the main entry way. This development will provide necessary parking and alleviate some of the ongoing noise concerns expressed by adjacent homeowners.
- DEEP staff installed 500 feet of post and rail oak fencing (materials obtained from agency mill) to define locations that parking and staking of dogs are not allowed in. This was another measure to minimize issues with adjacent homeowners.
- Dumpster Funding continued for removal of trash on a periodic 35-week basis.
- Herbicided stonedust walkway and chips around the clubhouse and conducted periodic mowing.
- Staff conducted debris clean-up after storm events. Still and ongoing item.
- DEEP obtained the required wetlands permit, appropriate large diameter culvert (6 ft), purchased

materials and utilized agency staff and equipment to resolve a long standing emergency road repair along Namerick Brook.

Continue work on revisions to the existing DEEP-FFTA Agreement.

## Work Planned-2012

- The Division will continue herbicide treatments during the month of July to further control nonnative invasive plants.
- Continue to provide dumpster services.
- Continue to conduct extensive moving activities throughout the month of August.
- Continue to administer three (3) agricultural agreements on the area. Benefits derived will include road maintenance, purchase of gravel, and continuation of food/cover plots.
- Complete revisions to the existing DEEP-FFTA Agreement

# **Other Items**

- A DEEP permit is needed for all field trials scheduled for the Flaherty area. Clubs should be reminded that applications for field trials should be received in the Wildlife Division office at least two or three weeks prior to the trial to allow for processing and mailing. This year in particular, there were several instances of not allowing proper advance notice regarding permit requests.
   Also, please minimize the need for changing and adding date requests.
- A meeting with the Association's officials will be scheduled early in the new year to discuss specific management of the area for the upcoming year.
- Please remember that all overnight camping and corralling of horses shall not extend beyond one day prior to and one day following a sanctioned field trial, unless so authorized.
- Club members should be reminded that the interior access roads on the field trial grounds are
  restricted to authorized use for emergency, patrol, and management of the area by DEEP. DEEP
  Regulations Section 26-16-3a prohibits the use of all-terrain vehicles, motorcycles,
  snowmobiles and all other motorized vehicles on any wildlife management area unless so
  designated by the Department. The only individual granted permission for ATV use on the
  property was a hunter who was issued a special permit for this year's hunting season.
- Please advise all field trial participants to show the utmost courtesy to the surrounding landowners and the general public that frequent the area.
- Any problems or conflicts on the Flaherty area, which need immediate attention by DEEP's Environmental Conservation (EnCon) Police should be reported to DEEP's Emergency Dispatch Center (24 hour communications) at (860) 424-3333.

In closing, please remember that the Department recognizes the long standing positive relationship that has existed with the Association. We support and encourage the historic field trial activities upon which the Flaherty grounds were developed and have been enhanced throughout the years. I hope that the

membership understands our agency's responsibilities in managing this unique property and can see why we have undertaken some of the actions we have this past year to ensure the long-term viability of the area.

**Subject: New Pointing Breed Hunting Test Advanced Titles** 

The Performance Events Department has received inquiries from many owners requesting additional hunt test activities in which they can participate with their dogs. In addition, clubs have consistently expressed concerns about losing participants after they earn their initial titles because many owners lack the time or resources to train for higher level tests. These owners still enjoy getting out in the field and remaining active to the extent that they can.

This past summer all licensed clubs were surveyed regarding the idea of a "numeric" title. (Pass the Junior Hunter test five more times and earn a JH2.) While the majority was in favor, 40% thought "what's the point?" This reaction is to be expected since the traditional thought regarding the purpose of field events has been to improve the dog and the breed. In the process, the sport provides an enjoyable activity for owners and their dogs. For many hunt test participants the enjoyment of spending time in the field with their dog and other owners is more important than identifying future breeding stock.

The Purpose of the Advanced Hunt Test Title

The creation of the Advanced titles is meant to encourage owners to improve upon the skills of their dog in the field by providing a slightly more difficult test that is not out of reach for the majority of owners thus providing them an incentive to remain active within their club and sport.

### The Criteria

Advanced titles may be earned in all three testing levels. After a dog has earned its initial title in a given testing level, it may continue to enter the same test. To receive a qualifying leg toward the Advanced title, the dog must achieve an average score of 8.0 or higher. (Note: The average qualifying score for the initial title is 7.0.) The categories scored at each testing level remain the same. There should be no change in how dogs are scored. Five Advanced qualifying legs are required to earn the Advanced title.

### The Process

From a club's point of view, there is no difference in how an event is conducted. Dogs working toward Advanced titles run in the same classes as those working toward their initial titles. It is not necessary that the Judges know which title a dog is working toward. Event secretaries do not need to do anything different. If a dog receives an average score of 7.0 or greater, it should be submitted on the AKC results form as a passing

dog. The dog will be recorded in AKC records as having achieved a qualifying performance. While the system will accept many passing performances, no title beyond the initial one will be awarded.

The tracking of a dog's Advanced title qualifying legs must be done on an AKC form entitled "Pointing Breed Hunting Test Advanced Title Application Form." The form is attached to this e-mail and may be downloaded from the AKC Pointing Breed Hunt Test website at:

www.akc.org/pdfs/events/hunting tests/pointing breeds/PBHT Advanced Title Application.pdf.

It is the owner's responsibility to obtain the information required to complete the form. Note that the event secretary must sign the form verifying that the dog received an average score of 8.0 or higher. Upon achieving five Advanced qualifying legs, the form is submitted to the Performance Events Department. The Title

Upon verification the title is placed on the dog's record and will appear on a dog's pedigree. The Advanced title is designated by the addition of the letter A at the end of existing titles. (Junior Hunter Advanced [JHA], Senior Hunter Advanced [SHA] and Master Hunter Advanced [MHA]). No title certificate will be issued unless ordered through the use of the application form for a fee of \$20. Ordering a title certificate is at the discretion of the owner. The Advanced title will supersede the initial title earned in the test level. For example, JHA will supersede JH on a dog's pedigree. A title earned in a more advanced level will supersede the Advanced title in a lower level. For example, SH will supersede JHA.

The Advanced title program becomes effective February 1, 2012. Any Advanced title qualifying performance after that date achieved by a dog that has already earned the initial title in a given testing level can be counted toward an Advanced title.

### **Additional Hunt Tests**

There are some areas where Pointing Breed Hunting Tests are routinely full. In response to this and the possibility that the Advanced title program will create additional demand, clubs will be allowed to hold up to six hunting tests per calendar year at their option.

A Pointing Breed Hunting Test Advanced title is awarded when a dog passes five additional times with an average qualifying score of 8.0 or higher <u>after</u> earning its initial title in a test level. Information regarding each of the five passes shall be recorded on this form. Event secretaries must sign verifying the average score (rounded to the nearest tenth of a point). It is the owner's responsibility to obtain the information required to complete this form. <u>Once five passes have been completed, this form is submitted by the owner to the AKC Performance Events Department.</u> Upon verification, the title is placed on the dog's record and will appear on the dog's pedigree. The Advanced title is designated by the addition of the letter A at the end of existing titles. No title certificate will be issued unless ordered through the use of this form for a fee of \$20. Ordering a title certificate is at the discretion of the owner. The Advanced title will supersede the initial title earned in the test level. For example, JHA will supersede JH on a dog's pedigree. A title earned in a more advanced level will supersede the Advanced title in a lower level. For example, SH will supersede JHA on a dog's pedigree. Please keep a copy of this form for your records. *Any qualifying performance achieved after February 1, 2012 by a dog that has already earned the initial title in a given testing level may be counted toward an Advanced title.*
